<sup>2</sup>"Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand."

<sup>10</sup>Your kingdom come. Your will be done, On earth as it is in heaven.

<sup>15</sup>Then the seventh angel sounded; and there were loud voices in heaven, saying, "The kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of our Lord and of His Christ; and He will reign forever and ever."
- **John 18:36-37**  
<sup>36</sup>Jesus answered, "My kingdom is not of this world. If My kingdom were of this world, then My servants would be fighting so that I would not be handed over to the Jews; but as it is, My kingdom is not of this realm." <sup>37</sup>Therefore Pilate said to Him, "So You are a king?" Jesus answered, "You say *correctly* that I am a king. For this I have been born, and for this I have come into the world, to testify to the truth. Everyone who is of the truth hears My voice."

<sup>18</sup>For I know that nothing good dwells in me, that is, in my flesh; for the willing is present in me, but the doing of the good *is* not.

## Main Points

- That which Jesus came to bring is bigger than our personal relationship with Him
  - Not to diminish our relationship with Him, but to think and live outside of ourselves
- The Kingdom of God is on earth now in “seed form”
  - It is now growing and bearing fruit, but still has yet to take full control
- For there to be a Kingdom, there must be a King
  - Jesus is King!
- To enter the Kingdom of God, we must submit to the King
- The King of the Kingdom expresses His authority through the Word of God!

1. Explain what it means to say that the Kingdom of God is here on earth now, but still in “seed form.”
2. How can you take steps in your life to live more for the Kingdom, outside of just your personal relationship with God?
3. What was Jesus talking about when he said the Kingdom of Heaven is like a mustard seed?
4. Transitioning into the Beatitudes, discuss how being poor in spirit is foundational to living for the Kingdom.
