## *The Trinity*



### **Main Points**

- Jesus is the Word of God, that has always been, clothed in humanity.
- God is the Father, Jesus is the Word and the Son, and the Holy Spirit is the Comforter.
- The Trinity: God exists eternally as the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.
- God does not have to be singularly unified to be ONE.
  - In marriage 2 become 1.
  - The many parts of the Tabernacle become one Tabernacle.
- The word ONE in English is Echad in Hebrew.
- Within God there is relationship.
- The English word baptism is Mikvah in Hebrew. When Jesus was baptized, all three members of the Trinity were present.
- You can embrace with your heart what your intellect cannot understand.
- Any definition of the Trinity that does not include relationship falls short.
