Scripture

- **2 Peter 3:8-9(KJV)**

But, beloved, be not ignorant of this one thing, that one day is with the Lord as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day. The Lord is not slow about His promise, as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not wishing for any to perish but for all to come to repentance.

- **Exodus 34:6 (MEV)**

And the Lord passed by before him, and proclaimed, “The Lord, The Lord God, merciful and gracious; slow to anger, and abounding in goodness and truth, keeping mercy for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, but who will by no means clear the guilty visiting the iniquity of fathers on the children and on the children’s children, to the third and the fourth generation.”
