Main Points

- If you ask God to teach you His ways, He will teach you His ways!
- When we pray about things concerning the nature of God in us, we can have confidence that God will hear and answer us.
- If we want to know the ways of God, we need to develop a supernatural mindset.
- God is Spirit and Spirit is Supernatural—above the natural.
- We live above the natural by confessing God's Word.
- Our faith is based on the supernatural.
