## Scripture

- **2 Samuel 22:35**  
He trains my hands for battle, so that my arms can bend a bow of bronze.

## **Main Points**

- Jesus is a warrior!
- We need to learn how to fight in order to achieve spiritual victory.
- There are two dynamics at work in the scriptures about the kingdom:
  - Dynamic #1: The Kingdom of heaven is being assaulted by forces of darkness.
  - Dynamic #2: A holy resolve not to compromise the Kingdom of God.
- We need to be aware of who Jesus is in order to walk in His fullness.
- We can't show mercy to the devil, because the devil doesn't understand mercy.
- The devil only understands authority and power.
- Sometimes we must back up our authority over the devil with power!
- We drive demons out of our lives by exercising authority and power over them.
- The same power that raised Jesus from the dead is at work in your life and the authority that Jesus has is upon your life.
- Demons primarily operate through our thoughts.
- When an ungodly thought comes into our minds we need to take it captive.
  - "I reject you Satan. Get out of my head!"
  - Do not own the thoughts in your heads. Command them out of yourself. Deliver yourself from passivity, through standing up and speaking to it.

## **Discussion Questions**

1. Summarize some of the principles of spiritual warfare that the Rabbi taught today.
2. Authority is not volume. Authority is power given by God to you over the Enemy. In faith-filled confidence you can command the enemy out of your body, head and airspace. This authority or power is strengthened through prayer and fasting and relationship with the Son through the Word. What steps do you need to take to be more proficient in spiritual warfare?
