Nathanael said to him, "Can any good thing come out of Nazareth?" Philip said to him, "Come and see." Jesus saw Nathanael coming to Him, and said of him, "Behold, an Israelite indeed, in in whom there is no deceit!" Nathanael said to Him, "How do You know me?" Jesus answered and said to him, "Before Philip called you, when you were under the fig tree, I saw you."

"...Because I said to you that I saw you under the fig tree, do you believe? You will see greater things than these." And He said to him, "Truly, truly, I say to you, you will see the heavens opened and the angels of God ascending and descending on the Son of Man."

Main Points

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RABBI'S PRAYER FOR MORE



Father God, in Jesus name I repent of not going after the more. I want more of you, and I am not going to let anything hold me back. Discussion Questions

2. What is the main reason people hold back from utilizing spiritual gifts in their own life today? Have you been reluctant to operate in the gifts God has given you? Write a little about your heart's response to today's message. How can you move from passivity to actively walking in His Spirit?
