Main Points

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Discussion Questions

1. What do you think Rabbi means by "a living experience with God"? Do you experience a real relationship with God? Write a little about this. Begin to ask God to increase Himself in your awareness.

2. What is the difference between religion and experiencing God? Would you like to experience God more in your life?

3. What are some avenues of connection to Jesus that are experiential that Rabbi brought out of John's Gospel? Review the verses from John above and take note of these. How was Jesus experienced in each of these passages? How aware of Jesus are you in your day to day life?

4. If you are not accustomed to telling Father God that you love Him, why not begin a new habit today? Begin to express your love for Him, and ask Him to help you experience His love for you in ways you have never recognized before.
