## Main Points

  - שְׁמַע יִשְׂרָאֵל יְהוָה אֱלֹהֵינוּ יְהוָה אֶחָד or Sh'ma Yisrael Adonai Eloheinu Adonai Ehad or in English, Hear, O Israel; the Lord our God, the LORD is one.
  - Sh'ma or hear
- We are led by the Spirit of God by abiding in the inner witness, intuition, that comes from the Holy Spirit.
- When your heart is right, God will train you how to tell the difference between what's of Him and what is not.
- We have to become so dependent on the Spirit of the Lord that we move when He moves and stop when He stops.

### **Discussion Questions**

1. God desires to communicate with His children. Rabbi emphasized the tongue of fire God gave, and the way God uses dreams in people's lives, not to mention the quickening of His Word in our hearts and minds as we immerse ourselves in it. The question is, are we listening and have we trained our senses to discern the voice of His Spirit? Evaluate where you are on the subject of hearing God and write down some specific things you can do to further train yourself in this area. Are there some things you sense God saying to you about areas of your life?
  
2. Rabbi spoke of the "intuition" of the Spirit speaking in our life. Have you ever recognized this intuitive communication from the Lord? It is also called an inner witness. How do we discern between the inner witness of God's Spirit and those spirits that are not? What should we keep in mind about the time involved in allowing God to train us in this walk of faith? What did Rabbi mean by saying we are either winning or we are learning?
  
3. How does paying attention to our intuition in the Spirit mirror the children of Israel in the desert and depending on the cloud and the fire? The promise of abiding in Him is bearing much fruit. Begin to record the ways you are hearing from God and the results in order to encourage you and remind you of the things you are learning.
