

Prophecy, Dreams, Visions Season 1: What Your Dreams Are Telling You



Scripture

- **Genesis 28:10-16**

Then Jacob departed from Beersheba and went toward Haran. He came to a certain place and spent the night there, because the sun had set; and he took one of the stones of the place and put it under his head and lay down in that place. He had a dream, and behold, a ladder was set on the earth with its top reaching to heaven; and behold, the angels of God were ascending and descending on it. And behold, the LORD stood above it and said, "I am the LORD, the God of your father Abraham and the God of Isaac; the land on which you lie, I will give it to you and to your descendants. Your descendants will also be like the dust of the earth, and you will spread out to the west and to the east and to the north and to the south; and in you and in your descendants shall all the families of the earth be blessed. Behold, I am with you and will keep you wherever you go and will bring you back to this land; for I will not leave you until I have done what I have promised you." Then Jacob awoke from his sleep and said, "Surely the LORD is in this place, and I did not know it."

Main Points

- God will sometimes show you your future, in advance in a dream, so when your future arrives, you'll be ready.
- God speaks to his people in dreams.
- We need to be listening.
- We need to be paying attention.
- We need to take the appropriate action.
- We can receive comfort from God through our dreams in a way that far surpasses the comfort that any human being could ever give us.
- We can receive assurance, comfort, and affirmation about our lives and about our relationship with God by paying attention to our dreams.
- God encourages us and affirms us through our dreams at night.
