The Law of Resistance: Darkness in Disguise

## <u>Main Points</u>

- When we resist the forces of darkness, we build up internal power in the Holy Spirit, that causes us to overcome and be conquerors for God.
- We need to learn how to resist the darkness that disguises itself as an angel of light.
- We need to practice the law of resistance.
- That which we see in the physical world is a shadow of what exists in the invisible realm.
- God is the Giver and He created mankind to be the receivers.
- God created us to be receivers.
- We have to resist trying to fulfill our desires by yielding to false light.
- The key to understanding how to resist false light is to be able to have the spiritual discernment to recognize that it is false.
- Through resisting, the power of the Holy Spirit is built into our soul, and we shine as the lights of Jesus in this world.
