Questions

- 5. Is our life meant to be a consumer life or a supernatural life? What is the difference? Which lifestyle reflects a continuous action rather than one with an expiration?
- 6. Reflect on your life. Is your pursuit of the zoe life a passion or a hobby? How can you begin to see this change?
