Scripture

• <u>Isaiah 61:1</u>

The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me, because the LORD has anointed me to bring good news to the afflicted; He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to captives and freedom to prisoners.

• Luke 4:14-21

And Jesus returned to Galilee in the power of the Spirit, and news about Him spread through all of the surrounding district. And He began teaching in their synagogues and was praised by all. And He came to Nazareth, where He had been brought up; and as was His custom, He entered the synagogue on the Sabbath, and stood up to read. And the book of the prophet Isaiah was handed to Him. And He began to say to them, "Today this Scripture has been fulfilled in your hearing."
