Main Points

- Being a follower of Jesus is much more than our cultural definition of what it means to be a "Christian."
- Are you **abandoned** to God?
- There's a price to pay for following Jesus.

- Part of living in Eternity involves understanding the present moment in light of the **big picture.**
- Since "The Fall" man has been living in deception and self-deception.
- Those that have been redeemed are presently **contending** for the eternal life to which we have been called.
- Eternity is a reality that is outside of time and outside of space.
- To know God is to experience eternal life.
- Recognize that what is happening **now** is oftentimes the result of a fallen world that is deceived!
- There is much more than "the now"!
- How to live in the power of eternity:
 - Live looking forward to Heaven.
 - Bring the power and revelation of Eternity into the present moment.
