Main Points

- Don't let the attack of the enemy stop you. Keep going forward!
- Spiritual Attacks:
 - 1). Recognize that you are being attacked.
 - 2) Enter your spiritual stronghold.
- The English world Fortress/stronghold in Hebrew is Metsuda.
- The Bible illustrates what is happening in the natural realm with what is actually going on in the spiritual realm.
