Main Points

- Types of Breakthroughs
 1. Circumstances
 2. Spiritual
- Every circumstance will fade away.
- Circumstances are like furniture in that they can't do anything for us.
- How can we get breakthrough in the Spirit?
- The Hebrew transliteration of the English word Holy Spirit is Ruach HaKodesh
- How can we get breakthrough so we can better know God and His nature through the Person of Yeshua (Jesus)?
- Hebrew Moment
 - Yahweh: God's Covenant Name
 - God is alive and He is continually new.

- True spiritual power resides on the inside and begins with knowing that you've already got it.
- God hears and answers the slightest impulse of our heart that is directed towards Him, when we are walking with Him.
- The greatest breakthroughs happen when we realize we are complete in Him, He is already in us, and we are walking in fellowship with Him.
- People with supernatural anointings should expect a supernatural attack.
- The way to exercise authority over the enemy is to declare that we already have authority over him.
