- Everything that God created was created for a purpose.
- As we learn to fight and overcome, we are empowered in the Spirit in ever greater ways.
- Many of the thoughts attacking you are from the realm of spiritual darkness.
- The Philistines were a physical manifestation of the powers of darkness.
- Do you recognize that you are in a war? And do you recognize when you are under attack?
- The first thing you should do when under spiritual attack is draw near to God.
