Main Points

- Breakthrough involves having opposition.
- Breakthrough: Coming against something that before had hindered us.
- We need to gain a greater sense that spiritual warfare is real.
- Our real problem is the **thoughts** we are having, and thoughts come from the **realm of the spirit** (both good and bad).
- The thoughts we have are either coming from the **Spirit of God** or **the powers of the enemy.**
- During Spiritual Attacks:
 - Go to the stronghold (to the center of yourself, where Jesus is).
 - Go against the enemy.
- Jesus didn't react to the **circumstance** but lived by a **higher revelation** and had breakthrough!
- During Spiritual Attacks:
 - Go to the stronghold (to the center of yourself, where Jesus is)
 - Go against the enemy.
- We should be so in touch with His Spirit that **when He moves**, we move.
- When we get in touch with His Spirit, learning to be led by Him, we will experience significant **breakthrough**!
