Scripture

- **2 Samuel 5:17-20**

When the Philistines heard that they had anointed David king over Israel, all the Philistines went up to seek out David; and when David heard of it, he went down to the stronghold. Now the Philistines came and spread themselves out in the valley of Rephaim. Then David inquired of the LORD, saying, "Shall I go up against the Philistines? Will You give them into my hand?" And the LORD said to David, "Go up, for I will certainly give the Philistines into your hand. So David came to Baal-perazim and defeated them there; and he said, "The LORD has broken through my enemies before me like the breakthrough of waters." Therefore, he named that place ^[1]Baal-perazim. ²¹ And *the Philistines* abandoned their idols there, so David and his men carried them away.²² Now the Philistines came up once again and spread themselves out over the Valley of Rephaim. When David inquired of the LORD, He said, "You shall not go directly up; circle around behind them and come at them in front of the balsam trees."

Main Points

- The power for breakthrough resides in each one of us.
- Jesus lives in you and He is the God of breakthrough!
- Your destiny is breakthrough!
- We are going to be in a spiritual battle for our entire lives.
- We need to establish within ourselves a soldier's mentality.
- One of the primary ways the enemy attacks is through fear.
- The thoughts in our mind are spiritual.
- When **breakthrough** happens, idols are destroyed!
- Often, when we have fears, it is because there's an idol in our heart in which we are not putting God first.
- Many of the things we fear, we fear because we have made these things an idol.
- Has the thing you are afraid of become an idol in your life?
- Different attacks of the enemy require different strategies.
