Scripture

- **Deuteronomy 6:4**
Hear, O Israel! The LORD is our God, the LORD is one!
- **Genesis 1:12,16-18, 21, 25**
The earth brought forth vegetation, plants yielding seed after their kind, and trees bearing fruit with seed in them, after their kind; and God saw that it was good.
¹⁶God made the two great lights, the greater light to govern the day, and the lesser light to govern the night; He made the stars also. God placed them in the expanse of the heavens to give light on the earth, and to govern the day and the night, and to separate the light from the darkness; and God saw that it was good.
²¹God created the great sea monsters and every living creature that moves, with which the waters swarmed after their kind, and every winged bird after its kind; and God saw that it was good.
²⁵God made the beasts of the earth after their kind, and the cattle after their kind, and everything that creeps on the ground after its kind; and God saw that it was good.

Main Points

- When we read Scripture, there's more meaning than just a surface meaning.
- Messiah in Hebrew is Mashiach
- Go beyond "cultural" Christianity.
- Revelations to set you free:
 - We exist within God.
 - After everything was created, He said 'it was good' with only one exception.
- God values us, our uniqueness, and He's looking for us to be a love partner to Him.
- God is looking for you to voluntarily choose to think about Him.
- There's nobody that can love God for you, you have to love Him yourself.
- Our destiny is only fulfilled when you recognize that you're a unique individual with power to love God.

2. What is a mystery in the spiritual realm? Can we know and understand these?
3. Concerning the first revelation, write in your words what it means that we exist within God.
4. How can we be separate from God? How is marriage a picture of this?
5. Why is our separateness a means of bringing glory and pleasure to God?
6. When you choose to accept the invitation to love God and demonstrate it in your life by your acts for Him, you are fulfilling your destiny. How does this make you feel? Does this change for you the concept of obedience? Does this increase your motivation to "love Him"?
