# <u>Scripture</u>

#### • John 1:18-

No one has seen God at any time; God the only Son, who is in the arms of the Father, He has explained Him.

#### • <u>Romans 11:36</u>

For from Him, and through Him, and to Him are all things. To Him be the glory forever...

## • <u>Ephesians 1:3-5</u>

# <u>Main Points</u>

- Jesus is the way to the destination, not the destination. The Father is the destination.
- The Son, Yeshua, has always been in the bosom of the Father.
- The primary relationship that we have been called into is a son and daughter to the Father.
- The primary relationship in all of existence is the relationship between the Father and the Son.
- The only reason you are a child of God is because the Father brought you sovereignly to Himself.
- Your faith in God is a result of the Father teaching you.
- You have a destiny as a son or daughter of the Father!
- There is a purpose every day. Our purpose is to be conformed to the image of Jesus and to know God as our Father.
