Scripture

- **Leviticus 23:1-2, 24-25**

The LORD spoke again to Moses, saying, “Speak to the sons of Israel and say to them, The LORD’S appointed times which you shall proclaim as holy convocations—My appointed times are these...

24”Speak to the sons of Israel, saying, ‘In the seventh month on the first day of the month you shall have a rest, a reminder by blowing of trumpets, a holy convocation. You shall not do any laborious work, but you shall present an offering by fire to the LORD.’”

Other Scriptures

- Leviticus 23:2
- Exodus 19:16; 20:18-19
- Luke 24:13-31

Main Points

- The English name Leviticus in Hebrew is Vayikra.
- The Hebrew word Emunah means faith. We say Amen.
- If you are a gentile, you have been grafted into the commonwealth of Israel.
- Fall Holy Days include
 - Rosh Hashanah or Yom Teruah, or Feast of Trumpets (Sept.25-27, 2022)
 - Yom Kippur or Day of Atonement (Oct. 4-5, 2022)
 - Sukkot or the Feast of Tabernacles (Oct. 9-16, 2022)
- Rosh Hashanah/Yom Teruah/Feast of Trumpets
 - 1. When this holy day happens
 - The seventh month in God’s Calendar is called Tishrei.
 - Leviticus 23:24-‘...in the seventh month on the first of the month...’
 - 2. What we are supposed to do on this holy day.
 - Blow trumpets
 - Do no laborious work.
- The Bible finds its climax in the person of Yeshua.

Discussion Questions

1. Are the holy days on God's calendar only for people who are Jewish? Why or why not?
2. What event does the Feast of Trumpets commemorate? How did God demonstrate in nature His presence?
3. What supernatural event preceded God's powerful entry into the world in Exodus?
4. On the road to Emmaus, Jesus brought together the events of the Old Testament and His coming into the world? From His teaching, what is the take-away concerning His place in God's plan and revelation?
5. Has Rabbi's teaching moved you more toward recognizing this Feast of the Lord in your own calendar? Write about what God might want you to do during the Feast of the Trumpets? What might this day look like in your home and life?
