Main Points

- Our walk with the Lord should be made up of a combination of the written word and the Spirit.

- The reason the Lord intervenes in our lives supernaturally is love.
- God wants you to know His love and He wants to be loved back.
- The reason God wants to work more supernaturally in our lives is so that we would know His love and love Him back.
- God delights over you!
