

# The Blood of the Lamb

---



## Scripture

- **John 1:29**  
“Behold, the Lamb of God...”
- **I Corinthians 5:7**  
“Christ our Passover also has been sacrificed.”
- **Exodus 12:3, 5-6, 7, 13, 22**  
“...take a lamb for themselves, according to their father’s households, a lamb for each household.”  
“Your lamb shall be an unblemished male a year old”. “You shall keep it until the fourteenth day of the same month...”  
“then the whole assembly of the congregation of Israel is to kill it at twilight.”  
“...they shall take some of the blood and put it on the two doorposts and on the lintel of the houses in which they eat it. They shall eat the flesh that same night, roasted with fire, and they shall eat it with unleavened bread and bitter herbs.”  
“The blood shall be a sign for you on the houses where you live, and when I see the blood, I will pass over you, and no plague will befall you to destroy you when I strike the land of Egypt.”  
“You shall take a bunch of hyssops and dip it in the blood, which is in the basin, and apply some of the blood that is in the basin to the lintel and the two doorposts; and none of you shall go outside the door of his house until morning.
- **Exodus 24:7-8**  
Then he took the book of the covenant and read it in the hearing of the people; and they said, “All that the Lord has spoken we will do, and we will be obedient!”  
So, Moses took the blood and sprinkled it on the people, and said, “Behold the blood of the covenant, which the Lord has made with you in accordance with all these words.”
- **Leviticus 17:11**  
“For the life of the flesh is in the blood, and I have given it to you on the altar to make atonement for your souls; for it is the blood by reason of the life that makes atonement.”
- **Leviticus 14:4-7**  
“...the priest shall give orders to take two live clean birds and cedar wood and a scarlet string and hyssop for the one who is to be cleansed. The priest shall also give orders to slay the one bird in an earthenware vessel over running water. As for the live bird, he shall take it together with the cedar wood and the scarlet string and the hyssop and shall dip them and the live bird in the blood of the bird that was slain over the running water. He shall then sprinkle seven times the one who is to be cleansed from the leprosy and shall pronounce him clean and shall let the live bird go free over the open field.”
- **John 6:53-56**  
So, Jesus said to them, “Truly, truly, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you have no life in yourselves. “He who eats My flesh and drinks My blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up on the last day. He who eats My flesh and drinks My blood abides in Me, and I in him.”
- **Revelation 5:12; 7:14; 19:9**  
Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power and riches and wisdom and might and honor and glory and blessing.”  
“These are the ones who came out of the great tribulation, and they have washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.”  
“Blessed are those who are invited to the marriage supper of the Lamb.”

## Main Points

- He that knew no sin gave up His life so that you and I can be made whole before our Creator.
- ***Passover begins sunset of Wednesday, April 5<sup>th</sup>, 2023 and ends at sunset, Thursday, April 13<sup>th</sup> 2023.***
- It is not enough to believe Jesus died for our sins; we need to apply it to our own lives.
- There is no way to be saved, except to have the blood of Jesus applied over our individual souls.
- The blood of Jesus is the only provision God has made for us to be able to stand acceptable before Him.
- Do you believe in Jesus from afar, or have you received Him into your life by making Him your Lord?
- Every day is a day of dying to self and submitting to the lordship of Christ, whose blood covers our life.

## Discussion Questions

1. How does the story of the Passover demonstrate the importance of the blood for our own cleansing of our sin? How did Rabbi demonstrate the unity of the New Testament to this idea? How do we know Jesus is our Passover sacrifice?
  2. Why could Jesus be our sacrifice for sin?
  3. What did Rabbi mean when he said it isn't about your parents' faith, but our own?
  4. What is the only provision God has made for us to be acceptable before God?
  5. Have you made Jesus your Lord? If not, why not today? If so, are you dying to self daily? What would prevent you from doing so?
