Discerning Reality

Scripture

- **Ecclesiastes 2:14**
The wise man's eyes are in his head...
- **John 4:9-14**
Therefore, the Samaritan woman said to Him, "How is it that You, being a Jew, ask me for a drink since I am a Samaritan woman?" Jesus answered and said to her, "If you knew the gift of God, and who it is who says to you, 'Give Me a drink,' you would have asked Him, and He would have given you living water." Main Points
