
- God's Sacred Name in Hebrew is YHWH

- Bereshit is the Hebrew transliteration for "in the beginning".
- Elohim is the Hebrew transliteration for God.
- God is multidimensional, and He has relationship within Himself.
- Within the Godhead, there is community.
- God is an "us".
- When you understand that God is "Us", it transforms our worldview.
- God wants us to live in relationship with others with this same type of paradigm.


Discussion Questions
