

Reaching Jewish People With the Gospel: The Remnant Will Respond



Scripture

- Acts 2:22-24

“Men of Israel, listen to these words: Jesus the Nazarene, a man attested to you by God with miracles and wonders and signs which God performed through Him in your midst, just as you yourselves know—this Man, delivered over by the predetermined plan, and foreknowledge of God, you nailed to a cross by the hands of godless men and put Him to death, But God raised Him up again, putting an end to the agony of death, since it was impossible for Him to be held in its power.”

- Romans 10:1-9

Brethren, my heart's desire, and my prayer to God for them is for their salvation. For I testify about them that they have a zeal for God, but not in accordance with knowledge. For not knowing about God's righteousness and seeking to establish their own, they did not subject themselves to the righteousness of God. For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to everyone who believes. For Moses writes that the man who practices the righteousness which is based on law shall live by that righteousness. But the righteousness based on faith speaks as follows: “Do not say in your heart, ‘Who will ascend into heaven?’ (that is, to bring Christ down), or ‘Who will descend into the abyss?’ (that is, to bring Christ up from the dead).” But what does it say? “The Word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart”—that is, the word of faith which we are preaching, that if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.”

- Romans 11:1, 5, 26-27

I say then, God has not rejected His people, has He? May it never be! For I too am an Israelite, a descendant of Abraham, of the tribe of Benjamin.

In the same way then, there has also come to be at the present time a remnant according to God's gracious choice.

...”The Deliverer will come from Zion, He will remove ungodliness from Jacob. This is My covenant with them, when I take away their sins.

- Matthew 6:9

...Our Father which art in heaven, hallowed be they name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is heaven.
