- Shtayim, Shalosh, Sha-Ger meaning Two, Three, Launch
- The English word Lord in Hebrew is Adonai
- LORD is YHWH or Yud Hei Vov Hei (Yahweh)
- The Hebrew word Shemot is translated Exodus in English.
- God is in the present!
- God is continuous, unfinished action.
