## Main Points

- God's Purpose: that you and I would walk in the **victory of Jesus**, continuing to show His **authority** and **victory** over the powers of the air in this present age.
- In Christ Jesus there is forgiveness and remission of sin.
- **Shalom Aleichem** (Hebrew) means "peace unto you".
- Everything starts with the Father.
- **Ruach** (Hebrew) means breath.
- You get power by continuing to cry out to God in your weakness.

2. God wants to make Himself known through whom? What impact does this thought have upon you? How does Peter demonstrate God's posture toward those feeling disqualified for this role through failure?
3. What are we reminded about concerning the Father by Paul in Ephesians? Why did Rabbi say the Father is the destination and Jesus is the way to the destination?
4. Where does spiritual power come from? How do you receive it? Why does this weakness and desperation and need produce thankfulness, along with power?
5. What are your thoughts after listening to this teaching? Write a response to your Father concerning all that Paul has enlightened us about in Ephesians so far. What is the response of your heart toward these powerful truths?
