

# Encountering God's Fall Holy Days:

## *Embracing God's Appointed Times*



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### Scripture

“The LORD spoke again to Moses, saying, “Speak to the sons of Israel and say to them, “The LORD’s [Yahweh’s] appointed times which you shall proclaim as holy convocations—My appointed times are these;”

### Main Points

#### **THE LORD'S FALL HOLY DAYS 2024**

- *Rosh HaShanah/Yom Teruah (Oct 2<sup>nd</sup>-4<sup>th</sup>)*
- *Yom Kippur/Day of Atonement (October 11<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>)*
- *Feast of Sukkot/Feast of Tabernacles (October 16<sup>th</sup>-24<sup>th</sup>)*
- There is something extra that the Lord imparts to you when you come into alignment with the redemptive themes of the Lord's Holy Days.
- The Hebrew word Mikra means God's Festivals/ Holy days.
- God did not give man the Sabbath to oppress him, God gave man the Sabbath to *bless him*.
- The Hebrew word for LORD is YHWH-Yud Hei Vav Hei (Yahweh)
- The Lord's Holy Days carry with them the theme of Redemption.
- Celebrating the Lord's Holy Days attune us to walk in the substance of our salvation.
- The Feast of Trumpets is transliterated in Hebrew as Yom Teruah.
- You were grafted into the commonwealth of Israel when you put your faith in Jesus.

- When you receive the knowledge of the Torah as a disciple of Jesus, you reach a higher level of understanding.
- The Hebrew Bible is the foundation of Scripture.

## Questions

1. Why is remembering the Lord's Holy Days every year important to our walk with God, as Jew or Gentile?
2. The Rabbi emphasized that the Holy Days connect us to themes that are critical to our grounding in the faith. What things do believers tend to gravitate too in place of these themes?
3. Rabbi described a stronghold of thinking that keeps believers from moving into deeper revelation concerning relationship with God, and especially about the Holy Days? He said believers are stuck. Why is it important to tear down these constructs of thought and move deeper into the Old Testament themes through the Holy Days?
4. The church today is not walking in power. It is broken because it is separated from the foundation of faith, the Hebrew Bible. Have you examined the relevance of God's Holy Days for your life and your empowerment? Are you willing to do this, in order to experience an amazing "ascension" in your relationship with Him? Write about this.
5. How is Rabbi's message today different than a call to more religion? Take a moment to ask Father to especially reveal Himself as you embrace these appointed times on God's calendar.
