Main Points

THE LORD'S FALL HOLY DAYS 2024

- Rosh HaShanah/Yom Teruah (Oct 2nd-4th) sundown to sunset
- Yom Kippur/Day of Atonement (October 11th-12th) sundown to sunset
- Feast of Sukkot/Feast of Tabernacles (October 16th-24th) sundown to sunset
- Jesus did not come to create a new religion; He came to fulfill Judaism.

- Why is it **not** Jewish to believe in Jesus?
- The primary reason why Jews reject Jesus today stems from the pride and envy of the Pharisees and Sadducees of Jesus' day.
- Holy Numbers: Three
 - o Patriarchs of Israel; Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob
 - o Courts in the Temple; Outer court, Inner court, and Holy of Holies
 - o Father, Son, and Spirit
- Holy Numbers: Seven
 - The Branches on a Menorah
 - o Tishrei-The Month the Fall Holy Days fall on in the Jewish Calendar
- In order to receive from God, you have to make time to hear Him.
- The Feast of Trumpets/Yom Teruah (Hebrew)
- Also called Head of the Year/ Rosh HaShanah

Questions

- Rabbi said the Church's lack of Old Testament or Torah foundation and connection to it
 has led to softness. What did he mean? Is he calling us back to legalism? What does
 Jesus have to do with these holy days?
- 2. Why did the Jews in His day reject him as Messiah? Rabbi is calling Jews today to not be stuck in manmade religion, and Gentiles not to be stuck in their way of thinking which ignores the Hebrew Bible with the Holy Days. Write about what this challenge means for you today.
- 3. What must we first do in order to celebrate Yom Teruah and incorporate it into our faith practices? Each of the Holy Days is also a Shabbat. Rabbi stressed that God gave the Sabbath to man as a gift. How do we truly celebrate in spirit during the time of Shabbat, and during the Feast what are we remembering, outlined in Exodus 19?
- 4. What amazing thing happened when the heavenly shofars blew? In whose presence were the people of Israel? How did this seal them as a nation?
- 5. Will you enter into this Holy Day? How?
