## Key Points

→ Though Jesus says He was sent only to the lost sheep of Israel in Matthew 15:24, in Acts 10 God revealed to Peter that the time had come for the Gospel to be offered to the Gentiles as well.

→ The inclusion of the Gentiles contributed to the separation of Christianity from Judaism.

→ A curse was added to the liturgy of Rabbinic Judaism, developed in 90 AD at the Council of Yavneh, against anyone who didn't follow the way of the Pharisees. This had the affect of forcing Jewish believers in Jesus out of the synagogues.
