Main Points

- Sar Shalom is Hebrew for Ruler of Peace, Prince of Peace
- If you want to see God, you have to be so pure that His reality an shine in you and through you.
- In order to have fellowship with God we have to be like Him, and to be like Him we have to have a *Pure Heart*.
- To Him Who Overcomes:
 - o Revelation 2:7...I will grant to eat of the tree of life.
 - Revelation 2:11...will not be hurt by the second death.

- Revelation 2:17...a new name which no one knows.
- o Revelation 2:26...I will give authority over the nations.
- o Revelation 3:5...will thus be clothed in white garments.
- o Revelation 3:16...I will make him a pillar in the temple of My God.
- o Revelation 3:21...I will grant to him to sit down with Me on My throne.
- The Beatitudes give us the roadmap to walk a kingdom lifestyle on the earth.
- Being a peacemaker means looking to be a bridge builder.
