

# **Is Isolation Suffocating Your Faith?**

Decoding the Torah Season 2

**Core Message**: God has not called us to walk alone but as a people united in Messiah. The law in Exodus 12:6, requiring the whole congregation of Israel to slaughter the Passover lamb together, reveals the foundational importance of spiritual community. Yeshua's fulfillment of this law through His sacrificial death unites believers not only to Him but to each other. Living in isolation neglects the communal nature of our salvation and forfeits the full blessing of walking in fellowship. To honor Yeshua's sacrifice, we must wholly consume His grace and be fully engaged in the body of Christ.

# Main Bible Verses (NASB):

- Core Memory Verse: (Romans 12:5) "...so we, who are many, are one body in Christ, and individually parts of one another."
- **(Exodus 12:6)** "The whole assembly of the congregation of Israel is to kill it at twilight."
- (Exodus 12:46) "It is to be eaten in a single house; you are not to bring forth any of the flesh outside of the house, nor are you to break any bone of it."
- (John 1:29) "Behold, the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!"
- (John 17:3) "This is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent."
- (Acts 9:2) "...so that if he found any *belonging to the Way,* both men and women, he might bring them bound to Jerusalem."
- (Mark 15:33-37) "It was now about the sixth hour, and darkness fell over the whole land until the ninth hour... Jesus, crying with a loud voice, said, 'Father, into Your hands I commit My spirit.' Having said this, He breathed His last."
