Revelation Decoded: Season 2

Core Message: This teaching continues Rabbi Schneider's focus on the end times, drawing a strong parallel between the days of Lot and our current cultural climate. He emphasizes the pervasive presence of sexual immorality and confusion around gender and identity as signs that Yeshua's return is near. Rabbi lovingly challenges believers to confront sin, especially sexual sin, while also remaining grounded in humility and truth. The message is a call for courage, holiness, and bold witness as we approach the return of King Jesus.

Main Bible Verses (NASB):

- **Core Memory Verse: (Luke 17:28-30) "It was the same as happened in the days of Lot... It will be just the same on the day that the Son of Man is revealed."**
 - (Romans 6:14) "For sin shall not be master over you, for you are not under the Law but under grace."
