

The Only Thing That Will Hold You Together

Revelation Decoded Season 2

Core Message: This teaching centers on the "blessed hope" of Messiah Yeshua's return, calling believers to live with a fervent expectation and readiness. Rabbi Schneider recounts a personal vision that emphasized the transformative power of hope and the urgency of Messiah's return. As demonic influences return in greater force to a post-Christian world, the only answer is to cling to Jesus and prepare for His coming. Rabbi warns of increasing darkness and challenges but encourages the faithful to anchor their lives in Christ and be bold witnesses. The fulfillment of every soul's longing is found only in the person of Jesus, and He is coming soon.

- (2 Corinthians 5:8) "We are of good courage... and prefer rather to be absent from the body and to be at home with the Lord."
- (Psalm 92:2) "To declare Your lovingkindness in the morning and Your faithfulness by night."
- (Revelation 22:12) "Behold, I am coming quickly, and My reward is with Me, to reward each one as his work deserves."
