

How To Find the Father's Frequency

Mysteries in the Gospel of John Season 10

Core Message: This episode explores how Yeshua, our Good Shepherd, personally knows and leads His sheep. Rabbi Schneider teaches that Jesus calls us by name and desires a daily, intimate relationship in which we follow His voice and guidance. By learning to discern His voice from other influences, we walk confidently and securely through life. Trusting that Jesus goes before us dispels fear and worry about the future. The message calls believers to grow in spiritual maturity by daily seeking the Shepherd's presence and leadership.

Main Bible Verses (NASB):

Core Memory Verse: (John 10:1-3) "Truly, truly, I say to you, he who does not enter by the door into the fold of the sheep, but climbs up some other way, he is a thief and a robber. But he who enters by the door is a shepherd of the sheep. To him the doorkeeper opens, and the sheep hear his voice, and he calls his own sheep by name and leads them out."

- (John 10:4) "When he puts forth all his own, he goes ahead of them, and the sheep follow him because they know his voice."
 - (John 10:5) "A stranger they simply will not follow, but will flee from him, because they do not know the voice of strangers."
 - (John 10:10) "The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I came that they may have life, and have it abundantly."
 - (John 6:53) "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you have no life in yourselves."
 - (Exodus 33:15) "Then he said to Him, 'If Your presence does not go with us, do not lead us up from here.'"
 - * (Hebrews 5:14) "But solid food is for the mature, who because of practice have their senses trained to distinguish between good and evil."

Application Challenge of the Week:

Every morning this week, pause before starting your day and ask Jesus, "What do You want to show me today?" Take five minutes to listen and then journal what you sense Him to be saying. (Or come up with your own as the Lord leads):

- * Thank God that He knows you by name and calls you personally.
 - * Ask the Holy Spirit to sharpen your discernment to recognize Jesus' voice.
 - * Surrender any fears about the future to the leadership of your Good Shepherd
