

Echoes of the Exodus

Passover and the Power of Deliverance

Core Message: Passover is a season of deliverance, reminding us that God sees our suffering and comes down to rescue us. Just as He delivered Israel from Egypt, He desires to set us free from every form of spiritual bondage today. Through Yeshua, our Passover Lamb, we are delivered not only from outward oppression but from the internalized sin and brokenness that have taken root in our hearts. God’s purpose is to bring us into a “spacious land” — a new spiritual reality filled with His peace, freedom, and blessing. As we honestly confront our bondage and call upon Him, He faithfully leads us into true freedom.

Main Bible Verses (NASB):

Core Memory Verse: (Exodus 3:7) “The Lord said, ‘I have surely seen the affliction of My people who are in Egypt and have given heed to their cry because of their taskmasters, for I am aware of their sufferings.’”

- **(Exodus 3:6)** “He said also, ‘I am the God of your father, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob.’ Then Moses hid his face, for he was afraid to look at God.”
- **(Exodus 3:8)** “So I have come down to deliver them from the power of the Egyptians, and to bring them up from that land to a good and spacious land, to a land flowing with milk and honey...”
- **(1 Corinthians 5:7)** “Clean out the old leaven so that you may be a new lump, just as you are in fact unleavened. For Christ our Passover also has been sacrificed.”
- **(Psalm 133:1)** “Behold, how good and how pleasant it is For brothers to dwell together in unity!”
