The Mystery of the Tabernacle Season 1

Core Message: The Tabernacle reveals spiritual patterns that help believers walk in intimacy with God. Through the Bread of Presence, we are reminded that God’s face, love, and attention are continually directed toward His people, even when life is painful or confusing. Through the Altar of Incense, we learn that prayer is not merely a scheduled activity, but a continual reaching out to God throughout the day. The believer is called to trust God’s love in trials and to cultivate authentic, focused, thankful prayer that rises “straight up” before Him.

Main Bible Verses (NASB):

- **Core Memory Verse: (Job 13:15)** “Though He slay me, I will hope in Him. Nevertheless I will argue my ways before Him.”
- **(James 1:2–4)** “Consider it all joy, my brothers and sisters, when you encounter various trials, knowing that the testing of your faith produces endurance. And let endurance have its perfect result, so that you may be perfect and complete, lacking in nothing.”
- **(Matthew 6:10)** “Your kingdom come. Your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.”
- **(Matthew 6:33)** “But seek first His kingdom and His righteousness, and all these things will be provided to you.”
- **(Philippians 4:6)** “Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and pleading with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God.”
- **(Psalm 141:2)** May my prayer be counted as incense before You;
The lifting up of my hands as the evening offering.
