

3 Keys for Achieving Gods Plan for You

Mysteries in the Gospel of John Season 13

Core Message: Jesus' inner peace came from knowing that the Father had entrusted all things to Him, that He came from God, and that He was returning to God. Believers can live with the same settled confidence by recognizing that in Messiah they already possess every spiritual blessing and do not need the world to make them whole. Our identity is rooted in being chosen children of the Father, not in human approval, status, possessions, or success. We are delivered from endless searching and striving when we know we already have what we think that we lack. Our destiny is secure because God is conforming us to the image of His Son and bringing us home to Himself. Therefore, our daily purpose is to grow in faith and sacrificially love the people God has placed in our lives.

Main Bible Verses (NASB):

- **Core Memory Verse: (John 13:3)** "Jesus, knowing that the Father had given all things into His hands, and that He had come forth from God and was going back to God,"
 - **(John 13:1)** "Now before the Feast of the Passover, Jesus knowing that His hour had come that He would depart out of this world to the Father, having loved His own who were in the world, He loved them to the end."
 - **(Ephesians 1:3)** "Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ,"
 - **(John 6:44)** "No one can come to Me unless the Father who sent Me draws him; and I will raise him up on the last day."
 - **(1 Corinthians 13:13)** "But now faith, hope, love, abide these three; but the greatest of these is love."
 - **(1 John 3:1)** See how great a love the Father has bestowed on us, that we would be called children of God; and *such* we are. For this reason, the world does not know us, because it did not know Him.
